Comment on any disaster related solid waste activities that may have influenced diversion efforts with the county.

On February 5, 2008, a tornado caused widespread damage across Madison County--principally in the west central portion of unincorporated Madison County and in the northwestern section of the City of Jackson. Local emergency officials estimate that debris from the tornado produced 22,000 cubic yards in the county and 35,000 cubic yards of debris in the city.

The Jackson-Madison County Landfill reported a large increase (almost 38,000 tons) in 2008 totals over 2007 totals in the amount of waste disposed of by Madison County residents and businesses in its Class III/IV landfill and much of this increase can be attributed to the aftereffects of the February 5th tornado.

Source Reduction Activities

Describe source reduction and reuse activities by public or private entities by jurisdiction.

Madison County began its drop-off recycling program in 1996 using its convenience centers as collection points. The program currently collects non-ferrous metals, newspapers, cardboard, latex paint, and used tires.

The City of Jackson began a drop-off recycling program in February 2008 collecting all types of paper and plastics 1 and 2 at five locations across the city. The program is handled by Southeast Recycled Fiber LLC, a private business contracted with the City.

Only residential wastes are collected--no brush, construction/ demolition wastes, liquids, chemicals, etc., are allowed.

Used tires continue to be a problem for Madison County with large amounts of paperwork required. The amount the County receives from the State each year for the used tires program is inadequate and the County is forced to supplement its operation from general funds.

The County receives more than one-half-million visits to its convenience centers each year. Complaints are few while the level-of-service is high.
